Celebration of 58th Engineers' Day 2025 Theme: "Deep Tech & Engineering Excellence: Driving India's Techade".



The Institution of Engineers (India), Nashik Local Centre, celebrated the 58th Engineers' Day on 16th September 2025 at 3.00 pm at IEI-NLC's Ashoka Virtue Auditorium, Nashik.

September 15 holds a special place in the annals of the engineering fraternity, as it marks the birth anniversary of Bharat Ratna Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya, a towering personality in the history of Indian engineering. In recognition of his monumental contributions to national development and engineering, Sir Visvesvaraya was conferred the Bharat Ratna in 1955.

The Institution of Engineers (India) observes this day every year across its State and Local Centres to educate and inspire both society and the engineering community. The theme selected by the Council for this year was "Deep Tech & Engineering Excellence: Driving India's Techade", reflecting the importance of innovation and technology in shaping India's future.

On this occasion, a special session was arranged on "Designing Your Future: Success Mantras", delivered by Er. Madhur Patil (COO, Technoforce & Founder & CEO, Integra Skid System; Mechanical Engineer, Business Owner, Blogger, Trekker, Baker & Traveler).

The programme began with the lighting of the traditional lamp in front of the statue of Bharat Ratna Sir M. Visvesvaraya, followed by the welcome and introductory address by Chairman Er. Samir Kothari, who highlighted the history, achievements, and future plans of IEI Nashik Local Centre. Guests were felicitated with bouquets, and the session was anchored by Er. Vipul Mehta.

CELEBRATED THE ROYAL CHARTER DAY, HELD ON 13TH SEPTEMBER, 2025

It gives us immense pleasure to inform you that, The Institution of Engineers (India), Nashik Local Centre have been celebrated the Royal Charter Day, held on 13th September, 2025.

The grant of Royal Charter to The Institution of Engineers (India) took place on 9 September 1935 in The Court at Buckingham Palace of His Majesty King and Emperor George V. The grant of the Royal Charter was the first such recognition extended to a professional body which had its origin and functions in India.

The grant of a Royal Charter conferred independent legal recognition to IEI with specific object and purposes which also endowed the Corporate Members of the Institution with the right to use the title 'Chartered Engineer' after their names, implying that they are qualified engineers deemed worthy to hold a Charter.

To commemorate this landmark event, the Council of the Institution decided to celebrate 09 September every year as the Royal Charter Day across all its State & Local Centres.
